Pupil responsibilities

Parent responsibilities

- Ensure that your child wears the correct uniform (unless exempted on religious grounds) and that their P.E kit is brought to school.
- Support the school by encouraging the good behaviour of your child/children.
- Support your child/children with their homework to the best of their ability.
- Encourage your child/children's learning through extra-curricular activities and independent learning.
- Inform the school office staff of any change in your child/children's circumstances.
- Inform your child's/children's class teacher if you have any concerns regarding any aspect of your child/children's schooling.
- Endeavour to support the school and your child/children by participating in any meetings or social activities that the school requests them to attend.
- Behave respectfully and appropriately towards pupils, staff members and our parents/carers in and around school

Reepham Primary School's responsibilities

- Provide your child with a safe, inclusive and accessible learning environment.
- Provide a full and balanced curriculum.
- Provide regular and challenging homework.
- Promote high standards, good behaviour and mutual respect.
- Record and reward excellence.
- Record and discipline poor behaviour.
- Provide extra-curricular activities to develop the broader skills that will assist with the personal, social, physical and cultural development of pupils.
- Regularly meet with parents to feedback the progress of your child/children.
- Provide the necessary information regarding the policies and activities of the school and its pupils.
