### **School Uniform and PE Kit Policy**

At Reepham High School, we place great value on the importance of a uniform. It fosters a sense of community and pride among our students, and it's something we take pride in. During the most recent Ofsted inspection, it was noted that our uniform is "sharp," reflecting the pride our students take in representing the school.

As we approach the end of the term, I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of our uniform policy and provide some alternative options to our main uniform provider.

Uniform	list:

Blazer	The School Blazer with school badge on.
Shirts	A plain white long or short sleeved shirt which must be tucked in at all times.
Tie	The school tie.
Trousers	Plain black, straight cut and full length (must touch the shoes). No skinny fit trousers allowed. No leggings.
Skirt	The school skirt, worn correctly, not rolled.
Socks	Plain black socks with no logos. No sports socks.
Tights	Plain black tights.
Sweatshirt	<b>Optional</b> school v-neck sweatshirt with or without logo, worn under the blazer. No alternatives, only available from Birds of Dereham.
Jumper (Y11 only)	Black V-neck Jumper with or without logo.
Shoes	Plain black leather, polishable shoes. No sports shoes, boots or canvas shoes. See additional photos on website for clarification.
Hijabs	A plain black or dark blue head covering may be worn for religious reasons.
Outdoor Coat	No hoodies to be worn on the school site. Outdoor coats only over the blazer.
PE kit	PE kit is compulsory for all pupils. Please see website for further information. If forgotten or lost, pupils will be expected to borrow kit. Refusal will result in a lesson removal and a sanction.

	Nose piercings are permitted, but only if covered with a plaster until healed and
Nose	then a clear retainer to be used. We advise that any new piercings are done at
Piercings	the start of the summer holidays to give them time to heal so that they can be
	removed easily.
Hair styles	Hairstyles should not be extreme; this includes unnatural or sharp contrasts in
	colour, sharp contrasts in length and patterns or lines shaved into hair. Hair
	accessories should be discreet and functional.
Tattoos	Tattoos, permanent or temporary, are not permitted (it is illegal to tattoo anyone
	under 18).
Make up	Make-up or false eyelashes are not allowed in KS3. In KS4 make-up can only be
	worn if discreet.
	Nail varnish and false/gel nails are not allowed.

### **School Shoes**



Acceptable Black polishable school shoes only.





**Unacceptable** No canvas, trainers, pumps, plimsoles, walking boots, boots, Vans or Converse. Shoes must be flat with no platform or high heel and must be below the ankle.





### **Physical Education Kit**

### All PE kit items with school logos can be purchased from Birds of Dereham. Birds of Dereham

#### Compulsory kit:

- Reepham High School PE performance t-shirt (red/black) or plain red top.
- Reepham High School shorts (black) or plain black shorts or Reepham High School leggings (black)
  or plain black leggings.
- Reversible Rugby shirt (red/white).
- Knee length games socks (red/black) or plain black alternatives. <u>To be worn for ALL outside PE lessons in winter and spring terms.</u>
- Sports socks (white).
  <u>To be worn for ALL inside PE lessons and outside in the summer term.</u>

### Compulsory equipment:

- Outdoor studded boots Plastic/moulded studs (recommended) or metal studs.
- Training shoes Clean with appropriate grip for indoor/court use.
- Shin pads To be worn for Football lessons.
- Gum Shields <u>To be worn for ALL Rugby lessons.</u>

### Optional:

- Reepham High School track pants (black) or plain black alternative.
- Reepham High School sports midlayer (red) or plain red alternative.
- Reepham High School PE sweatshirt (black).
  <u>Only permitted to be worn during PE lessons and not as part of normal school uniform.</u>
- Reepham High School leggings (black) or plain black alternative.
- Skins/base layers for under the PE kit (black only).

### Any alternative kit options must be plain and of the required colour. Any branded clothing must be plain (small logos only).

### Please Note:

- ALL jewellery must be removed for ALL PE lessons.
- Any alternative kit options must be plain and of the required colour. Any branded clothing must be plain (small logos only).
- All previous Reepham High School PE kit remains fully acceptable.
- Hooded tops/coats are not permitted in PE lessons.
