## Archaeology: Digging up the Past!

This year we plan to visit to Norwich Castle, Dragon Hall, Grimes Graves, one of England's great archaeological sites; and Sutton Hoo, the site of two Anglo-Saxon cemeteries dating from the 6th to 7th centuries and where archaeologists have been excavating since 1938. Here, an undisturbed ship burial containing a wealth of Anglo-Saxon artefacts was discovered.

Alternatively, we are currently investigating the possibility of taking part in another archaeological excavation with the University of East Anglia. This would involve 4 days in the fresh air, in a beautiful location, carrying out important research and discovering things that nobody knows about while learning about the process of archaeology.

## **Art & Craft Workshop**

The week will include using clay, building 2D and possibly 3D items. Dry felting to create a range of different items from 2D flat pieces to more 3D models. This can be plants, animals etc.

Press Printing creating a range of cards. Then finally slow stitching, which is a method of stitching used to bring wellbeing and mindfulness.

This week is a chance to explore, experiment and develop new techniques.

We will be joined by Tracks – a mobile recording studio kitted out in the back of a van for two of the days and on the last day, we will be visiting Plug rehearsal rooms and recording studio in Norwich. As well as having a guided tour of their facilities and an introductory talk about the work they do, we will use one of their rehearsal rooms to practice a live version of our song and will then head into their studio to record it. The day will finish with an introduction to mixing and mastering.

By the end of the week – we'll have a finished original song that we have recorded!

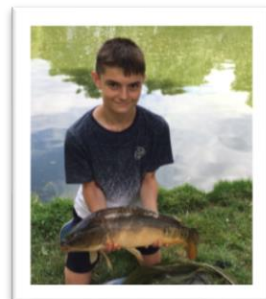
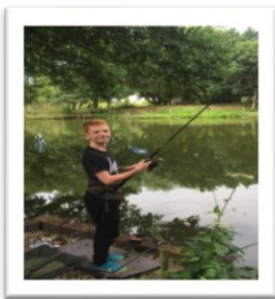
# Fishing

We are very lucky to spend our time fishing at Reepham Fishery again this year. It does not matter if you are a complete beginner or experienced angler, a boy or a girl, this fishery suits everyone. For the beginners we will have staff available to show you how to set up your rod and get catching straight away. It would help if you have your own fishing rod and tackle (or borrow from a friend) but we may be able to provide some (please request in advance at our first meeting). For the experienced angler there is the challenge to target your species or catch a personal best. In previous years we have caught Carp up to 13lbs, Tench up to 3lbs, Roach, Rudd and Orfe. There is never a quiet moment around the lake!

We will have three days to practise our skills and gain expert advice from the Fishery staff, they will then organise a fishing match for us. Our final day will include prizes and trophies for the match winners, biggest fish caught over the week and most improved angler.

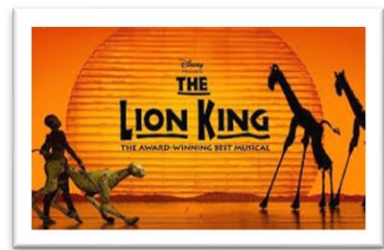


# London Thrills & Adventures: City Sights & Theme Park Delights

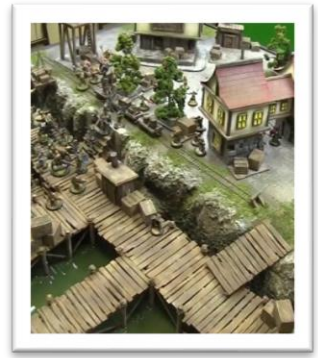
